Day 1: Arrival In Tallinn

Welcome on your "Wonders of Scandinavia" Tour.

On arrival in Tallinn, after your immigration clearance, transfer to your hotel and check in (Check In after 3 pm.)

Tallinn - historically known as Reval, is a the gorgeous capital city of Estonia. A city with evidence of over 5,000 years old civilization and which overlooks the Gulf of Finland.

Day 2: Tallinn City Tour

Enjoy continental breakfast at your hotel.

After breakfast proceed on a City Tour of Tallinn - one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Europe. We visit the old town which is UNESCO World Heritage site. Rich with historic buildings of mostly medieval time between the 13th-16th centuries.

First we visit the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral, a Russian Orthodox Church located on Toompea hill in the middle of city, built in Russian Revival style.

On our walking tour, we also explore Toompea Hill which also acts as the center of Estonian Government and Parliament House. The Parliament House, also known as Toompea Castle, is a medieval castle built in the 9th century. It has gone through several changes of rulers between Denmark's King Valdemar II, Teutonic Order, Sweden and occupations including a major rebuilding in the 13th century.

We proceed to the Dome Church that's also known as St. Mary's Cathedral. It is the oldest church in Tallinn, a Roman Catholic Cathedral which survived the disastrous 17th century fire.

Later, we check out the Gate of Lühike Jalg which also means "long leg."

Along this street is the Tall Walls of Tallinn that protect this city during sieges since 15th century.

Enjoy free time to see the place on your own or do some shopping.

Day 3: Ferry to Helsinki • Helsinki City tour

Enjoy continental breakfast at your hotel.

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and proceed to the ferry terminal to board your ferry to Helsinki. A 2.5 hours at sea, we arrive at the capital city of Finland, Helsinki.

Finland is known as the happiest country in the world or "Land of the midnight sun" or Nokias birthplace.

After disembarkation, we proceed on a city tour of Helsinki.

We begin our tour at the Senaatintori Square, also known as the Senate Square. It is a renowned and iconic location in Helsinki, primarily famous for the Helsinki Cathedral situated at its center. This square stands as a testament to the architectural prowess of Carl Ludvig Engel, symbolizing the intersection of political, religious, scientific, and commercial influences in the city's history. The square, along with its surroundings, boasts a rich historical significance, representing some of the oldest parts of Helsinki.

The Helsinki Cathedral itself is a national symbol, adorned with sculptures of the 12 Apostles, symbolizing protection for the city.

Another must-visit attraction is the remarkable Temppeliaukio Church, often referred to as the Rock Church. This unique Lutheran church was designed by architect brothers and is literally carved into solid rock, making it a one-of-a-kind architectural wonder.



Later we explore the picturesque English-style Sibelius Park, named in honor of the renowned Finnish composer, Jean Sibelius. This memorial park features the impressive Sibelius Monument, a striking sight that should not be missed during your visit.

The same is applicable to any delegate/attendee wanting to pay for their own stay. A valid invoice and cash receipt can be issued against the same. If the booking is done in advance, then 100% payment will have to be done by telegraphic transfer to our account or cheque/DD 01 week before the tour dates. Exclusive Trips shall not accept any liability or responsibility for any damages, loss, injury, accident, death, breakdown, irregularity, which may occur in carrying out the tour arrangement, weather conditions, strikes, war, quarantine and any other cause whatsoever and all such loss or expense must be borne by passenger themselves. Exclusive Trips will not be liable for any overstay expenses due to delay or changes in air or train schedule or other services due to sickness, weather conditions, strike, war, quarantine, or any other cause whatsoever. Insurance policies must be carried while on tour.

Cancellation Policy:

All services such as Airline seats / Hotel accommodation / ground transportation/ venues for tours/conferences/events are pre-blocked well in advance. We are liable to pay penalties to all our suppliers / vendors if these services are released within the below mentioned time frame.

All cancellations of bookings must be given in writing and acknowledged by ET. A transfer from one tour destination/event venue to another, prior to the date of the tour/conference/event will be treated as a cancellation, thereby attracting the cancellation charges as stated hereunder and a fresh booking on another. Detailed tour wise cancellation given below.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS & VISA

In order for passengers to undertake international travels it is mandatory to hold valid passport with minimum of 6 months validity from the date of return to India.

It is the passengers responsibility, to have the visa application made to the concerned Consulates / Authorities However, for certain cases, the Client may have to attend personal interviews at their own cost.

As granting or rejecting visas and immigration clearance is the sole prerogative of the concerned sovereign governments, Exclusive Trips shall neither be responsible in case of non-granting of such documents nor liable for any delay or other related act/omission or for any loss, expenses, damage or cost resulting from there.

Exclusive Trips would not be responsible in any way in case any clerical error regarding names, attachment of wrong photographs, duration, and type of visa (Single/Multiple entry) occurs in the consulate / embassy. Passengers shall be responsible to check the details, photos and the correctness thereof. In the event the application for visa made by any Client or the Company on behalf of the Client is rejected due to any other reason whatsoever, Exclusive Trips shall not be liable or responsible for the same.

All passports are required to be mailed for visas to different cities, company would mail the passport by reputed courier at an additional cost.

Consulates have every right to call for additional supportive documents; any guarantee from the corporate, personal appearance or reject the visa. Exclusive Trips will not be held responsible for such delays /rejection. If visa is rejected appropriate cancellation charges will be applicable.

It will be the responsibility of all the passengers to take care of their belongings at all times. Exclusive Trips will not be responsible for any loss or damage of any of the said belongings at any time.
